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

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### **GLOSSARY OF INVESTMENT TERMS**

A-1+/A-1 – Highest short-term credit ratings assigned by Standard & Poor's.

AAA – Highest long-term credit rating assigned by Standard & Poor's and Fitch.

Aaa – Highest long-term credit rating assigned by Moody's.

AA+ – Second highest long-term credit rating assigned by Standard & Poor's and Fitch.

**Cash in Pool** – Residual amounts of money invested in the Pooled Investment Fund that cannot be reasonably invested in separate investment securities (amounts typically less than \$100,000 per fund).

F1+/F1 – Highest short-term credit ratings assigned by Fitch.

FFCB – Federal Farm Credit Bank

FHLB – Federal Home Loan Bank

FHLMC – Federal Home Loan Mortgage Corporation

FNMA – Federal National Mortgage Association

**Investment Agreement** – A contract between a bond issuer and a financial institution that provides the issuer with a guaranteed interest rate for the duration of the contract.

**LAIF** – Local Agency Investment Fund is the State of California Treasurer's Pool, which is created under Section 16429.1 of the Government Code. The County uses this account as a late draw savings account and as investments for TRANs proceeds.

P-1 – Highest short-term credit rating assigned by Moody's.

**Sweep** – A money market account at Wells Fargo that invests any residual dollars into overnight securities (similar to cash in pool).
