FICTITIOUS BUSINESS NAME STATEMENT PUBLICATION REQUIREMENTS

The California Business and Professions Code requires that Fictitious Business Name Statements be published as follows:

- Publication must begin within 30 days of the date of filing the Statement.
- If you are **renewing** with <u>no changes **and** within 40 days of expiration</u> of previous statement, it does not need to be published.
- Statements must be published once a week, for 4 consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in the county where the fictitious business name was filed.
- An affidavit of publication must be filed with the Business License unit within 30 days of completion of the publication (the affidavit is normally sent to our office by the newspaper - you may want to confirm that the paper you choose provides this service.)
- Statements of Abandonment must be published in the same manner as above.
- Statements of Withdrawal from Partnerships must be published in the same manner as above unless a notice of the dissolution of the partnership has been published pursuant to Section 15035.5 of the Corporations Code.
- If registrant has no place of business in this State, the notice must be published in a newspaper of general circulation in Sacramento County.
